- Educational Facility - Project Summary-

Project Name: UPEI School of Business – McDougall Hall – Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island

McDougall Hall opened its doors in the fall of 2008. The facility is home to the School of Business, the Centre for Life-long Learning, Three Oaks Innovation Inc., the Centre for Enterprise and Entrepreneurship, the PEI Bioalliance, Co-operative Education, International Education, and the Tourism Research Centre. The facility features a 4 story administration building (formerly Marion Hall building which was completely renovated) and a new 2 story building complete with 170 seat auditorium, lecture theaters, conference & breakout rooms.

The facility was designed in accordance to LEED Silver Certification standards. In addition to its sustainable nature and design the building features state-of-the art systems such as computer controlled dimmable lighting systems in the lecture theaters, day-lighting controls, multimedia conference rooms, computerized access control and surveillance systems, fibre optic main data backbone and LAN data systems to name a few.

The award-winning 50,000-square-foot building was showcased in the August 2008 issue of Canadian Architect

The total project cost was approximately \$9,200,000.00 with an electrical construction value of \$860,000.00.
